It is not necessary to bring your own computer. A well organized presentation on an USB stick is enough. It is important to speak max. 7 min, so we can stay in time.

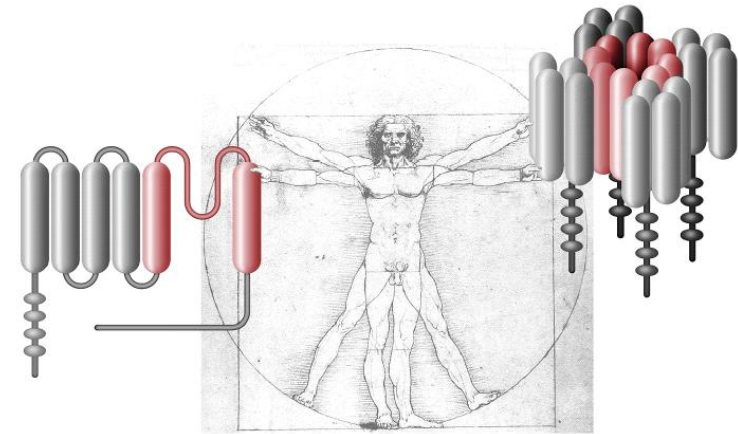
